CARBON REDUCTION PLAN

INTRODUCTION

This Carbon Reduction Plan produced by Serbus Ltd (“Serbus”) conforms to the requirements of PPN06/21. Our reporting year runs from 1st January to 31st December.

For the purposes of this document, Serbus Secure Limited and any other affiliated companies in the Serbus Group will be referred to as “the Company”, “the Employer”, “we” or “our”.

COMMITMENT AND AIM

The Company are committed to protecting the environment and safety and health of our workers, whilst providing quality products and services to our customers.

We aim to sustainably deliver our services to ensure the future of our ecosystem and to preserve resources for years to come.

The Company considers the social, economic, and environmental impact of our business in everything we do. We ensure that sustainability is considered through all our business decisions.

A framework of supplementary management systems and policies embed sustainability throughout our business (Health & Safety, Environmental & Community Engagement).

COMMITMENT TO ACHIEVE NET ZERO

The Company is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050.

BASELINE RECALCULATION AND REPORTING APPROACH

Following the merger of our three businesses under a single group structure, we have moved to a dedicated carbon reporting platform, Greenly, to provide a consistent, group-wide approach to emissions reporting.

Previously, each subsidiary reported on a different basis with varying methodologies and differing levels of category coverage. Where reporting did take place, it was largely calculated using the UK Government's greenhouse gas conversion factors spreadsheet, covering Scope 1, Scope 2, and a limited range of Scope 3 activities. As a result, the historical figures are neither consistent across the group nor complete enough to serve as a reliable comparison.

Our new platform has allowed us to measure a substantially wider set of Scope 3 categories on a consistent basis across all entities, most significantly purchased goods and services, calculated from procurement spend data drawn directly from our finance systems. Scope 3 was not captured extensively before and now represents the majority of our reported footprint, so reported emissions have risen accordingly.

This reflects both the consolidation of three previously separate reporting approaches and a material expansion in measurement boundary, rather than any change in our operations or performance. For these reasons, prior-year figures are not directly comparable, and we have adopted 2025 as our new group baseline year, against which future performance will be measured.
